Day by Day Itinerary

Wednesday, September 26

Fly from Milwaukee to Quebec City. Upon arrival you'll be met by your local tour guide for a panoramic city tour of Quebec followed by check-in at the **Hotel Manoir Victoria** located in the heart of Old Quebec. Tonight gather for a **Welcome Dinner**. (D)



Thursday, September 27

Breakfast buffet at the hotel is followed by a **walking tour with guide of Old Québec City**, the only walled city in North America and a **UNESCO designated World Heritage Site**. Visit Lower Town, Battlefield Park, and the Plains of Abraham, Palace Royal, see the Museum of Civilization etc.

Lunch- at Auberge Baker Inn - established in the 1850's, a quaint French country setting with authentic local cuisine.

This afternoon tour the Basilica St Anne de Beaupre with the guide. Visit Montmorency Falls and ride the cable car for the great Views, and have time to walk around and visit the gift shop. Later arrive back at hotel and enjoy the evening on own. (B,L)

Friday, September 28

Buffet Breakfast at the hotel followed by a guided tour at **La Citadelle**. This national historic site is a walled fortress of the city. The one-hour guided tour will highlight the American attacks, the construction of the fortress and its buildings. The visit of the Royal 22^e Régiment Museum located in an old French powder magazine (1750) and a former military prison (1842) is included in the tour.

Next take a **guided tour of the Chateau Frontenac**. Jump into the pervading atmosphere of the past and experience the present life style of the famous hotel! Charmed by a character right out of the late 19th century, you will discover the luxurious interior of the "World's Most Photographed Hotel"!

This afternoon board the **Norwegian Dawn** for your seven night cruise. (B,D)

Saturday, September 29

Enjoy a full day at sea. Enjoy a host of activities available on board. (B,L,D)

Sunday, September 30

Arrive 8:00 am / Depart 6:00 pm

Port of Call: Corner Brook. This corner of the world has been visited by many, beginning with the Maritime Archaic Indians 3,500 years ago. Since that time Eskimos, Portuguese, Basques and Captain James Cook have frequented the area. Today, Corner Brook is a modern, city nestled among scenic hills near the Gulf of St. Lawrence. (B,L,D)

Monday, October 1

Arrive 8:00 am / Depart 5:00 pm

Port of Call: Sydney. The coal industry brought immigration from many parts of the world, giving Sydney a multicultural mix of over 50 ethnic backgrounds and a global flavor to its history. Located on Cape Breton Island, Sydney is also an ideal jumping-off point for scenic adventures. (B,L,D)

Tuesday, October 2

Arrive 8:00 am / Depart 5:00 pm

Port of Call: Halifax. Admire the rugged coastline the surrounds Halifax, the world's second-largest natural harbor. This beautifully preserved city is Nova Scotia's capital and was founded in 1749. Take steps through history and climb to The Citadel to witness the Old Town Clock. (B,L,D)

Wednesday, October 3

Arrive 10 am / Depart 7:00 pm

Port of Call: Saint John (Bay of Fundy). Saint John's history is evident in its weather-worn look, passing the tests of salt air, sea winds and a devastating fire that have all contributed to making Saint John the greatest little city in the east. Be sure to look for your ship in the port against the beauty of the Bay of Fundy from Fort Howe lookout. (B,L,D)

Thursday, October 4

Arrive 8:00 am / Depart 5:00 pm

Port of Call: Bar Harbor. This coastal attraction has retained much of its charm since its glory days of the 1900s, when America's elite vacationed here in opulent summer cottages. Surrounding the rock-bound harbor is the world-famous Acadia National Park where the opulence of nature is on display. (B,LD)

Friday, October 5

Arrive 8:00 am

Port of Call: Boston. Boston Welcome to an American city where history truly does come to life. Be sure to visit Bunker Hill Monument, Paul Revere's House, the Old North Church, Quincy Market and the mansions of Beacon Hill. Then wander Boston Common, the oldest public park in the U.S. (B)
