Wed, June 2	Arrive in Fairbanks and check into your hotel for a 2-night stay. Remainder of day at leisure.
Thu, June 3	Morning at leisure. This afternoon enjoy a cruise on an authentic sternwheeler riverboat . The evening is free to spend as you choose in Fairbanks.
Fri, June 4	Transfer to Rail Depot for a scenic rail ride from Fairbanks to Denali . Check-in at the Denali Princess Wilderness Lodge. Evening at leisure.
Sat, June 5	Morning departure for Natural History Tour followed by scenic motorcoach ride from Denali to McKinley . Check-in at McKinley Princess Wilderness Lodge, located on the south side of Denali Park. The lodge offers dramatic views of the continent's tallest peak from the Great Room, dining room and deck. For a bird's-eye view, soar over this stunning massif in a helicopter or bush plane. How will you spend your day? Walk the extensive trails around the lodge, or opt for flightseeing or river rafting. Evening at leisure.
Sun, June 6	Transfer from the lodge to the Rail Depot for rail ride from Talkeetna to Anchorage . Transfer from depot to hotel for check-in. Remainder of day at leisure in Anchorage.
Mon, June 7 8:30 pm	Today Alaska Wildlife Conservation tour followed by transfer to ship and embarkation. Tonight set sail for your 7-night Voyage of the Glaciers Cruise on board the Island Princess.
Tue, June 8 3:00 pm - 8:00 pm	Hubbard Glacier Scenic Cruising Hubbard is one of Alaska's few advancing glaciers. Ever on the move, previous activity earned it a nickname — the "Galloping Glacier." Your cruise will capture its explosive power as you linger along its shimmering five-mile-long face.
Wed, June 9 10:30 am - 8:30 pm	Glacier Bay Scenic Cruising This spectacular national park and preserve displays massive glaciers that stretch 3.3 million acres from the St. Elias and Fairweather mountain ranges to the ends of the fjords. It is home to an amazing world of marine life, including humpback whales, sea otters, porpoises and harbor seals. It also possesses the highest concentration of tidewater glaciers on the planet.
Thu, June 10 7:00 am - 8:30 pm	Skagway Few one-time boomtowns retain the flavor of the gold rush days like Skagway. This gateway to the Klondike is preserved as a national historic park with its rustic boardwalk and frontier-style storefronts. Due to its geographic location, Skagway enjoys a drier climate compared to the rest of southeastern Alaska, with an average annual precipitation of only 22 inches.
Fri, June 11 6:30 am - 4:00 pm	Juneau Perched on a thin strip of land at the mouth of Gold Creek, Juneau is arguably one of America's most beautiful state capitals, with the looming summits of Mt. Juneau and Mt. Roberts providing a gorgeous backdrop.
Sat, June 12 10:00 am - 6:00 pm	Ketchikan This southern-most Alaskan port city is known as Alaska's First City because it was the first major community travelers came to heading north. Founded as a fishing camp, Ketchikan is built on steep hillsides and is billed as the salmon capital of the world. A quaint village, the town is just three miles long and three blocks wide.

Mon, June 14 7:30 am	Arrive Vancouver where you'll transfer to the airport for your return flight home.

Air from Chicago: Air with Princess Cruises is \$1045 pp at this time and is subject to change. Another option is to sign up for Viking Travel's group air at \$825 pp; however, we will need a minimum of 10 passengers to secure this price. This special group air price has to be paid in full by January 31, 2010. Every effort will be made to honor seat requests. Requests however, cannot be guaranteed.
