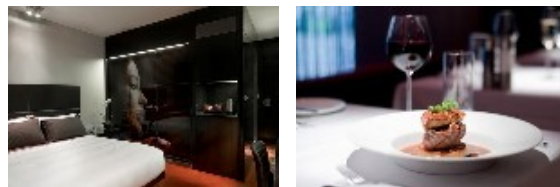

Day 1 – Tuesday, Sept. 11– Depart U.S.A. We board our overnight transatlantic flight

Day 2 - Wednesday, Sept. 12 – Arrival in London, England. We will be met by our Tour Director and transferred to the hotel. The afternoon is at leisure to rest or explore independently. Many of London's most famous sights are within close walking distance to our hotel: Big Ben, the Houses of Parliament and the London Eye. Tonight we join our companions for a Welcome Dinner at the hotel. (D)

Day 3 – Thursday, Sept 13 – London City Tour and Shownight. After a hearty English breakfast, we depart for morning sightseeing with a Local Guide including all the famous Landmarks of London: the Houses of Parliament and Big Ben beside the River Thames, Whitehall's mounted horse guards, the Prime Minister's Downing Street, Piccadilly Circus and Buckingham Palace. Highlights include a drive past St. Paul's Cathedral and a visit to Westminster Abbey, and the ceremonial pageantry of the Changing of the Guard, if held. Afternoon at leisure to discover the city on our own. Tonight, Shownight is included. A marvelous evening in London's theatre district starts with a gourmet dinner at The Bank Restaurant in Westminster, followed by great seats at the Victoria Palace Theatre to see the original London staging of the inspirational musical "Billy Elliot." (Note: It is possible that the theatre production may be different.) (B, D)

Day 4 – Friday, Sept 14 – London – Full Day Excursion to Shakespeare Country. This morning we head into the country for a lovely day of sightseeing. In Stratford-upon-Avon we take our pictures of Anne Hathaway's Cottage and visit Shakespeare's birthplace, with time afterwards to explore this pretty Elizabethan town at our own pace. We take a drive into the Cotswold Hills to enjoy the picturesque villages and idyllic rolling English landscapes. At Oxford, city of the dreaming spires, we take a walking tour to discover the famous university colleges where Britain's elite receive their outstanding educations. We return to London around 6:00 pm with the rest of the evening free. (B)

Day 5 – Saturday, Sept 15 – London – Windsor Castle and Tower of London. In the morning, we depart for an excursion to Windsor Castle. We will receive a guided visit to the Queen's favorite residence, the largest inhabited castle in the world. The highlight is the newly refurbished staterooms. Next, we enjoy an excursion to the Tower of London and the Crown Jewels. Our guide will bring the 900 year old tower to life before we inspect the fabulous Crown Jewels. Transfer back to the hotel. (B)

Day 6 – Sunday, Sept. 16 – At Leisure. A full day at leisure to attend church services and to create your own adventure in this interesting city. Ask your Tour Director for suggestions. Most shops are open on Sundays with shorter hours, usually 11am – 5pm. (B)

Day 7 – Monday, Sept. 17 – London – Buckingham Palace and the Royal Mews and A Taste of London Pub & River Cruise Experience. Our morning is free for last-minute shopping or sightseeing on our own. In the early afternoon, we depart for our excursion to Buckingham Palace and the Royal Mews. Buckingham Palace serves as both the office and London residence of Her Majesty The Queen. During August and September when the Queen makes her annual visit to Scotland, the Palace's state rooms are open to visitors. These are the heart of the palace, lavishly furnished with some of the greatest treasures from the Royal Collection which are used for ceremonial occasions and official entertaining. Before entry to the palace, you will visit the Royal Mews, one of the finest working stables still in existence. See the State vehicles, both horse-drawn carriages and cars, used for coronations, royal weddings and State visits, including the magnificent Gold State Coach which has been used for every coronation since 1821 and was last used for The Queen's Golden Jubilee in 2002.

Tonight, A Taste of London. Ideal for our farewell to London, this guided evening excursion combines a traditional London pub experience with a relaxed, night-time river cruise, viewing some of the capital's most beautiful illuminated sights. We will enjoy a three-course dinner at an historic London pub in the city of London, followed by the cruise. (B, D)

Day 8 – Tuesday, Sept 18 – Transfer to the Airport. We transfer to the airport for our return flight home.
