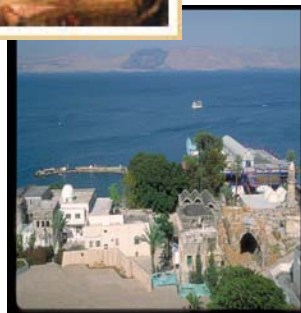
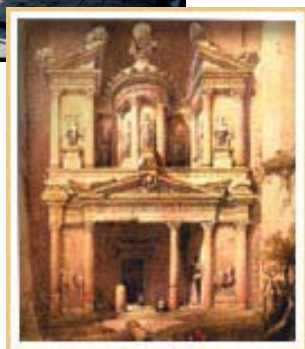
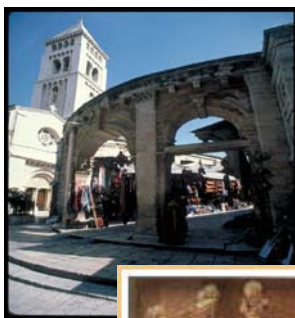

DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

Day 1-May 9 Depart Chicago on our way to Tel-Aviv, Israel.

Day 2-May 10 Arrive at Ben-Gurion Airport where your representative greets you and gives you an introduction to the forthcoming trip. Proceed to our hotel in Galilee for the overnight stay.

Day 3-May 11 Today we tour the Sea of Galilee. We will visit Capernaum and Simon Peter's House, the Mount of the Beatitudes and Tabgha-the site of the feeding of the multitudes. Take a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee and enjoy a St. Peter's fish lunch in Tiberias; then back to our hotel for overnight stay.

Day 4-May 12 This morning we drive through the village of Cana-site of Jesus' first miracle-and continue to Nazareth-site of the Annunciation and the Virgin Mary's house. Afternoon visit to the Golan Heights and Caesarea Philippi. Return to our Galilee hotel.

Day 5-May 13 As we head for Jerusalem, we drive to the top of Mt. Carmel and view Megiddo in the Valley of Armageddon. Continue along the coast to Caesarea where Paul was imprisoned and Cornelius was baptized. We will visit the ruins of the Roman theater and aqueduct on our way to the Holy City-Jerusalem-for our overnight stay.

Day 6-May 14 Today we visit Bethlehem where we will see the Church of the Nativity and the Shepherds' Fields. As we walk into the old city of Jerusalem we will experience the Christian, Jewish, Muslim and Armenian quarters of the Old City. We will see the Temple ruins and the Temple Mount, and walk the traditional Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Then it is on to Mt. Zion to see David's Tomb, the Room of the Last Supper and to the City of David. Our overnight stay is in Jerusalem

Day 7-May 15 In Jerusalem today, we'll visit the Mount of Olives, the Garden of Gethsemane, the Church of Peter in Gallicantu (cock-crowing)-built over the palace of the high priest Caiaphas-and the Garden tomb. In the afternoon we will see the Shrine of the Book-where the Dead Sea Scrolls are housed-and visit Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial. Again, our overnight stay is in Jerusalem.

Day 8-May 16 Today we journey to the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan. Steeped in history and humankind's earliest settlements, villages and relics of many of the world's great civilizations can still be seen today in Jordan. Tour Madaba with its beautiful mosaics and Mt. Nebo, from where Moses viewed the Promised Land. We continue our journey to Petra for our overnight stay.

Day 9-May 17 The "Red Rose" city of Petra is our primary focus today. We will enter through the passage "siq" and walk through the wonders of that city carved on the mountains. After lunch, we recross the border into Israel and drive to the Dead Sea, where we will enjoy the evening at the lowest point on earth. Our overnight is at Dead Sea.

Day 10-May 18 Our first stop today is a tour of Massada, the site of the Jewish zealots' last stand against the Romans; onto Ein Gedi, site of the Qumran Caves, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. In the afternoon we drive to Jaffa to see St. Peter's Church and the House of Simon the Tanner. Together we enjoy a farewell dinner before our transfer to the airport for our late departure (or overnight in Tel Aviv (depending airline schedule) to the United States!

Cancellations made from time of reservation to within 90 days prior to departure = \$125 fee plus insurance premium and any air penalties.

Cancellations made from 89 to 65 days of departure = 75% of the land cost, plus any air penalties.
