Day 8 Vienna: Guided Sightseeing tour and free time.


Day 9 Budapest: Guided sightseeing and a visit to Heroes' Square

Day 10 Budapest (Disembarkation): Your vacation ends this morning. Transfer to the Airport for our return Flight.




AVALON ILLUMINATION DECK PLAN:


Sky Deck




Royal Deck



Documentation: A valid passport is required for travel. Passports must be valid for a minimum of 6 months from return date. Names on reservations must match passports exactly.

Airfare: Subject to Avalon and all airline terms and conditions and may not qualify for miles.

Transfers: Included with Avalon air on travel days only. Flight Arrival & Departures Guidelines: Arrival 6am-5pm / Departure 6am – 5 pm.

Pricing: Based on a minimum of 20 passengers and does not include optional travel insurance, optional shore excursions, premium seating if applicable, meals off the ship and items of personal nature, such as passport and phone calls or anything not indicated as included.

Cancellation Policy: If you must cancel, the following per person penalties apply. Without exception, all cancellations must be in writing (letter, fax or email) to Viking Travel Service and are effective the date of receipt. Any unused portions of the package are non-refundable.

No shows or no written notice will result in 100% penalty.

Date of Deposit to April 1, 2019 = \$700 pp penalty plus insurance premium.

April 2, 2019 to July 1, 2019 = 75% pp penalty / July 2, 2019 to departure: 100% total charges.
